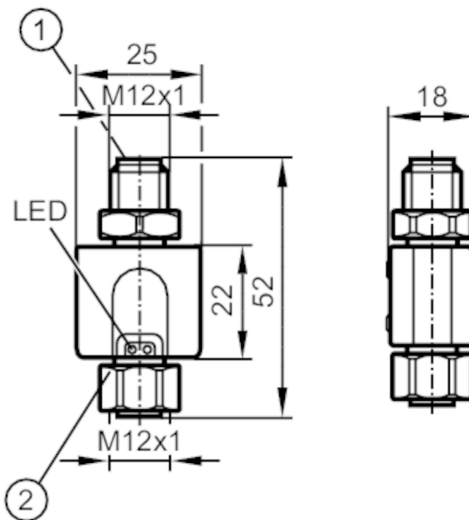


IO-Link memory plug

MEMORY PLUG



- 1 connection for voltage supply and output signals
2 connection for temperature sensor

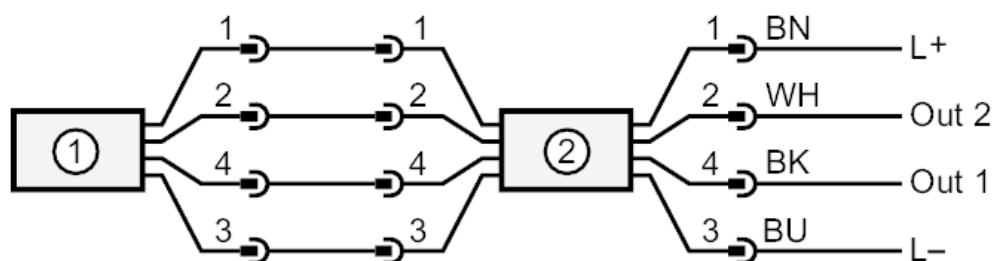
